RE: NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF REGISTRAR ACCREDITATION AGREEMENT

Dear Mr. Valdes:

Be advised that the Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers (ICANN) Registrar Accreditation Agreement (RAA) with Parava Networks, Inc. (Parava Networks) (IANA No. 94) is terminated. As explained in greater detail below, this termination is based Parava Networks' failure to cure breaches set forth in ICANN's letter dated 27 February 2009. This termination shall be effective fifteen calendar days from the date of this letter, on 24 April 2009.

On 27 February 2009, ICANN sent Parava Networks a notice of breach of RAA based on Parava Networks' failure to escrow gTLD registration data, failure to take reasonable steps to investigate and correct, when necessary, claimed Whois inaccuracies, and failure to pay the accreditation fees, as required by the RAA. Consistent with Section 5.3.4 of the RAA, Parava Networks was given fifteen days to cure all breaches cited in ICANN's notice of breach. Based on Parava Networks' failure to cure those cited breaches within the time period specified by the RAA, Parava Networks' RAA is terminated. For your reference, a copy of ICANN's 27 February 2009 notice of breach and a current financial statement are enclosed.

To facilitate a smooth transition of the estimated 36,000 domain names currently managed by Parava Networks, ICANN will follow its De-Accredited Registrar Transition Procedure (Procedure) <http://www.icann.org/en/processes/registrars/de-accredited-registrar-transition-procedure-01oct08.pdf>. We encourage you to read the Procedure in its entirety. Consistent with the Procedure, we are requesting that Parava Networks designate a bulk transfer recipient on or before 14 April 2009. Please contact ICANN's Registrar Liaison

Manager, Mike Zupke mike.zupke@icann.org, to designate a bulk transfer recipient. We anticipate the full cooperation of Parava Networks during the transition process.

Please note that termination of Parava Networks' RAA does not relieve Parava Networks of the obligation to pay delinquent accreditation fees, which should be paid immediately. ICANN reserves the right to pursue all means available to collect these fees.

It is ICANN's goal to protect registrants from unnecessary harm and we look forward to amicably resolving any domain name transition issues that may arise from this termination.
