ICANN has conducted a preliminary review of DotAsia's request to implement DNSSEC in dot-ASIA, in accordance with the Registry Services Evaluation Policy and process set forth at <a href="http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html">http://www.icann.org/registries/rsep/rsep.html</a>.

Based on the information provided, ICANN's preliminary review did not identify any significant competition or security and stability issues. As noted in the proposal, implementation requires a modification to the data escrow section of the dot-ASIA Registry Agreement (signed 6 Dec 2006) and Appendix 1. The service is approved pending these modifications. We understand that DotAsia will continue to cooperate and consult with the appropriate ICANN staff and experts on details of the full implementation of DNSSEC in dot-ASIA.
